True, they are a headstrong people, but forgive us our faults and our sins, and adopt us as your heritage.'

Last week, Fr Marcus discussed the feedback with the Mission Team. In light of the feedback and discussion, Fr Marcus has decided that there will be no change to the Mass schedule for now.
